<p>Situation 7</p> <p>At recess, you are working in the library on a group assignment. You have organized to meet your group there, but only one student turns up. The others are all playing basketball instead.</p>	<p>Situation 8</p> <p>You have a class in the computer lab. There are twenty computers and twenty-one students. You and another student have to share the last computer. You both want to use it for different tasks.</p>
