

## How to Deliver an Effective Introduction

Start the lesson with a review of previously learned skills, homework, or prerequisites students will need to accomplish the target lesson. The review will informally assess students so you can gauge whether they are ready for the new learning or if reteaching is necessary prior to the delivery of the new lesson.

List what you will review and how you will review it prior to the target lesson.

- Homework?
- Questioning so that students can recall previous learning?
- Prerequisite knowledge and skills needed for the new learning?

Then provide an overview of the lesson, such as by verbally stating or listing the learning objectives.

- Identify the goals for the lesson.
