

Select and Reflect: Questions to Support Students Experimenting With Form

Questions to support students experimenting with form:

- ♦ What other ideas could work for developing my product, performance, or service?
- ♦ Could I omit certain parts and get different results?
- ♦ What happens when I try this?
- ♦ How might I record my results? How might I look at my data?
- ♦ Is there more than one solution? How do I know?
- ♦ What happens when I move parts around?
- ♦ What happens when I add colors? Descriptors?
- ♦ What happens when I apply a new process?
- ♦ What other materials might enhance my efforts?
- ♦ Am I satisfied with my results?
- ♦ What am I hoping will happen? When will I know it is time to try something different?
- ♦ What is my main challenge right now?
- ♦ How could I try that a different way?
- ♦ What do I want for both myself and others in this moment?
- ♦ Did my prototype give me the results I was hoping for? Why or why not?
- ♦ Did my new approach give me the results I set out to get? How could I adapt my new approach if I need to?
- ♦ What might cause this outcome?
- ♦ Did I consider multiple possibilities?
